Completed projects as at April 2024, are as follows:

- 1. Ecole Technique St Joseph, where SICOM sponsored part of the project for the purchase of tools and equipment to facilitate the training of students.
- 2. ANFEN Culinary School, where SICOM sponsored the culinary school for the acquisition of special tools, equipment, materials and related items.
- 3. Safire Breakaway Home, where SICOM sponsored part of the project for the purchase of equipment, furniture and other materials.
- 4. New Renal Transplant Outpatient Department at Victoria Hospital, where SICOM sponsored the installation of aluminium partitioning and the supply of furniture.

Ongoing projects as at April 2024, are as follows:

- 1. Extension of the Diabetic Foot Care Clinic at J. Nehru Hospital, Rose Belle, expected to complete by end of April 2024.
- 2. Plant nursery at women prison, Beau Bassin and Pointe la Gueule, Rodrigues, expected launch in May 2024.
- 3. Empowerment of women through mangrove propagation at Ferney, expected to complete by end of December 2024.
- 4. The 'Learning with Nature' project with the Mauritius Wildlife Foundation, which is ongoing for a period of 3 years.
- 5. SICOM Group has agreed to partner with FAREI for projects such as video clip production for planters, expo sales on bio products at SB1, creation of bio-farms at the Farmers Training School at Wooton and Autisme Maurice and is expected to complete by end of June 2024.
