



The Group is dedicated to addressing all significant concerns that affect stakeholders across its various businesses.

Completed projects as of June 2026 are as follows:

1. Organic fruits and vegetables expo sales, to support bio farmers, in collaboration with Food and Agriculture Research and Extension Institute (FAREI) in the context of World Environment Day 2026 at SICOM Building 1 and another at SICOM Tower earlier in November 2025.
2. Implementation of the Organic Household Garden project in Montagne Blanche, providing practical skills for chemical free backyard gardening to 50 residents in collaboration with FAREI.
3. Bio model farm established at Autisme Maurice in collaboration with FAREI.
4. Financial Literacy Programme delivered by SICOM staff to NGOs, Lovebridge Ltd and Adolescent Non-Formal Education Network (ANFEN) covering financial fundamentals, budgeting, basic investment concepts and procurement principles.
5. Learning with Nature programme in collaboration with the Mauritian Wildlife Foundation (MWF).
6. Supporting practical training in renewable energy for youths through the provision of an off-grid photovoltaic (PV) solar kit to the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD).
7. Beach clean-up event at Roches Noires Public Beach in collaboration with Mission Verte, resulting in the collection of 131 kg of waste.

Ongoing projects as of June 2026 are as follows:

1. Collaboration with FAREI on initiatives promoting bio-farming and supporting local farmers, including annual expo-sale of organic products and upgrading of the Wooton Farmers Training School.
2. Second year of agroforestry project in Rodrigues, implemented in collaboration with Foundation Ressources et Nature (FORENA), to promote biodiversity.
3. Embellishment of the front yard of the Natural History Museum in collaboration with Tiny Forest as part of biodiversity initiatives.
